

# RAYMOND TOWN BOARD MEETING JANUARY 5, 2026

The Raymond Town Board met in a regular meeting January 5, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. with all members present including Larry Brannan, Gale Filipek and Eric Mehlberg. Also present was sewer maintenance operator Darrin Leetch and finance officer Carrie Reis.

The minutes and financial reports were approved with a motion by Filipek and seconded by Mehlberg, all aye. The following claims were paid: NW Energy 602.98; Cook's Wastepaper 626.32; Darrin Leetch 377.88; Carrie Reis 454.84; Clark County Courier 36.76; Elan Financial 37.09, printer ink; IRS 758.34, withholdings; S.D. Dept. of Revenue 112.98, sales tax; Postmaster 78.00, stamps; Mehlberg Cleaning 280.00, cleaning; Clausen Construction 1,560.00, blading; Dakota Portable Toilets 125.00; Ace Hardware 110.95, supplies; SDML 50.00, annual dues; Fritz Enterprises 306.00, dumpground.

The board set the *Clark County Courier* as the official newspaper with a motion by Brannan and seconded by Filipek. All aye.

The 2026 salaries will remain the same with a motion by Brannan and

seconded by Mehlberg, all aye. Board members \$110/meeting; Finance Officer \$525/month; Sewer Maintenance/Mowing \$441.67/month.

The board reviewed the open meeting law brochure as suggested to do annually by SB74.

A list of the volunteer fire department members is on file with the finance officer.

Brannan made a motion to sign the annual inspection agreement with Dakota Pump as in previous years. Filipek seconded, all in favor.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned with a motion by Brannan and seconded by Filipek.
