The Raymond Town Board met in a regular meeting August 6, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. with all members present, including Eric Mehlberg, Gale Filipek and Bill Noethlich. Also present Darrin Leetch and Carrie Reis. The meeting was called to order by Mehlberg. The financial reports and minutes were approved with a motion by Filipek and seconded by Mehlberg.
